liquid dish soap

- * 2 cups soap shavings
- * 2-3 cups hot water

pour hot water over soap shavings and mix. let sit over night or several hours. stir to create uniform consistency. for less viscous - add more water. for thicker - add vegetable glycerin. for super grease cutting power - add lemon juice or vinegar.



liquid hand soap

follow directions listed above and pour into recycled containers.

All-Purpose Laundry Soap

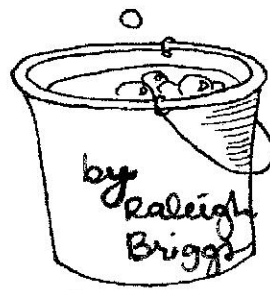
This is a low-lathering, unscented detergent you can use in a washing machine. If you want to scent it, you can dry and pulverize some scented castile soap (like Dr. Bronner's) to use in the recipe, or add a few drops of your favorite essential oil.

This recipe makes enough for three loads, but is very easily doubled or tripled.

- 1/2 cup baking soda
- 1/2 cup powdered castile soap
- 1/4 cup washing soda
- 1/4 cup borax

*NOTE: In order for the soap powder to dissolve, use warm or hot water in your machine. o

Mix ingredients well, add essential oils if you're using them, and stir again to break up any clumps. Use 1/2 cup per load.
